Rapid growth and turnover within police departments has resulted in officers having to deal with new duties often times without being fully or properly trained for their new assignments. In addition, misleading information seen on popular CSI television shows has created some misconception with the public. Regardless of the advancement in technology there are basic fundamentals in Criminal Investigation that should not be lost or overlooked. This 5-day course is a return to the basics.

Who Should Attend: Officers from small departments with growing responsibilities; Patrol officers that handle criminal investigations; Newly assigned detectives; Training officers setting up in-service basic investigative training programs; Officers and detectives wishing to improve their basic skills.

Topics will include: Securing the crime scene; Locating and questioning witnesses and victims; Documenting the crime scene; Sources of Information; Identifying and collecting evidence; Arresting and interrogating suspects; Analyzing Crimes in terms of how to proceed; Testifying in court.

About the Instructor: Captain (ret.) Chuck Hemp

Chuck served with the City of Oakland Park Public Safety Department in South Florida from 1962 to 1989. During that time, he was assigned to Patrol, Narcotics, Vice, the Intelligence Unit, Organized Crime Unit, and 12 years as a Lieutenant in the Major Case Squad.

In 2001, Chuck retired as a Captain with the State of New Hampshire Police Standards and Training Council after serving for 12 years. His duties involved teaching certified courses in Death Investigation, Internal Affairs Investigations and Crime Scene related topics in the police academy and in-service training. He has a Bachelor of Science Degree in Police Administration from Nova University and attended the 76th Session of the University of Louisville Southern Police Institute in 1986.

Chuck is an International Association of Identification (IAI) Board Certified "Senior Crime Scene Analyst", an Adjunct Instructor for the Institute of Police Technology and Management (IPTM) and the Southern Police Institute (SPI), and a member of the Southern Police Institute Alumni Association, the IAI, and the National Association of Underwater Instructors. As an expert in death investigations, Chuck has lectured and taught POST certified courses throughout the country.
